

MEWP (Aerial Lift) Fall Protection Inspection Form

Inspection Guidelines: Fall protection is required at all times when operating a boom lift or as required by the lift’s manufacturer. Complete this checklist before each use of the lift. Inspections must be conducted by a trained, authorized lift operator.

If the fall protection equipment fails any part of this inspection, report the condition to your supervisor and remove the equipment from service. Do not proceed with work.

Inspection Item	Pass	Fail	N/A
Full Body Harness: Free of cuts, burns, abrasions, fraying, excessive soiling, or other excessive wear and tear			
Hardware: includes D-rings, buckles, keepers, and back pads. Inspect for damage, distortion, sharp edges, burrs, cracks, and corrosion.			
Webbing: Inspect for cuts, burns, tears, abrasions, frays, excessive soiling, and discoloration.			
Stitching: Inspect for pulled or cut stitches.			
Labels: Inspect, making certain all labels are securely held in place and are legible.			
General Condition: Equipment free from any other degradations, damage, or defects.
