Surgical	<ul> <li>Disposable</li> <li>Covers nose and mouth</li> <li>Provides barrier protection against droplets including LARGE respiratory particles</li> <li>Does NOT effectively filter small particles from air<sup>(1)</sup></li> </ul>
N95	<ul> <li>Disposable</li> <li>Covers nose and mouth</li> <li>Filters out particles such as dust, mist, fumes</li> <li>Does NOT provide protection against gases and vapors</li> <li>Fit testing/Medical clearance required<sup>(2)</sup></li> </ul>
Half Face	<ul> <li>Reusable facepeice and replaceable cartridges or filters</li> <li>Can be used to protect against gases, vapors, or particles (if equipped with the appropriate cartridge or filter)</li> <li>Fit testing/Medical clearance required<sup>(2)</sup></li> </ul>
Full Face	<ul> <li>Reusable facepeice and replaceable canisters, cartridges or filters</li> <li>Can be used to protect against gases, vapors, or particles (if equipped with the appropriate cartridge or filter)</li> <li>Provides eye protection</li> <li>Fit testing/Medical clearance required<sup>(2)</sup></li> </ul>
PAPR	<ul> <li>Powered Air- Purifying Respirator (PAPR)</li> <li>Reusable facepeice and replaceable canisters, cartridges or filters</li> <li>Can be used to protect against gases, vapors, or particles (if equipped with the appropriate cartridge or filter)</li> <li>Battery powered with blower that pulls air through cartridge or filter</li> <li>Fit testing/Medical clearance required with tight PAPR (Loose PAPR does not require test/clearance and can be used with facial hair)<sup>(2)</sup></li> </ul>
